1	Page 1, Title	<p>Current Wording: BYLAWS IN BETA BETA STATE, HAWAII THE DELTA KAPPA GAMMA SOCIETY INTERNATIONAL Proposed Amendment: BYLAWS OF DKG HAWAII THE DELTA KAPPA GAMMA SOCIETY INTERNATIONAL</p> <p>RATIONALE: Name change of State organization to follow Article I, Section B of Constitutional Amendment Adopted by the 2018 DKG Convention</p>
2	Page 1	<p>Article I. Name, Sections 1 and 2 Section 1: Current wording: The name of this state organization shall be Beta Beta State, Hawaii of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International, hereafter referred to as Beta Beta State. Proposed amendment: The name of this state organization shall be DKG Hawaii of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International.</p> <p>Section 2: Current wording: Each chapter in Beta Beta State shall be designated by a Greek Letter or a combination of Greek letters assigned sequentially in order of chartering. Proposed amendment: Each chapter in DKG Hawaii shall be named by the State organization.</p> <p>RATIONALE: Name change of state organization to follow Article I, Section B of Constitutional amendment Adopted by the 2018 DKG Convention.</p> <p>NOTE: NAME CHANGE WILL CHANGE EVERY "BETA BETA STATE" TO "DKG HAWAII" IN THE ENTIRE BYLAWS AND STANDING RULES.</p>

<p>3</p>	<p>Page 1</p>	<p>Article III. Membership, Sections 1 and 2 Section 1: Current wording: The membership of Beta Beta State shall be composed of active, reserve, and honorary members. All membership is in accordance with the Constitution, Article III. Proposed amendment: The membership of DKG Hawaii shall be composed of active, reserve, collegiate, and honorary members. All membership is in accordance with the Constitution, Article III.</p> <p>Section 2: Current wording: An active member shall be a woman who is employed as a professional educator or has been retired from an educational position. An active member shall participate in the activities of the Society. Proposed amendment: An active member shall be a woman who is or has been employed as a professional educator at the time of her election. An active member shall participate in the activities of the Society.</p> <p>RATIONALE: Alignment of Bylaws with International Amendments to Article III, Membership, sections B1 and B4, establishing new collegiate classification of membership.</p>
<p>4</p>	<p>Page 2</p>	<p>Article IV. Finances, Section 1.C Section 1. Annual Dues, C: Current wording: Annual dues and fees shall be paid between July 1 and October 31 of each year. On November 1, members shall be dropped for non-payment of dues and fees. Proposed amendment: Annual dues and fees shall be in accordance with Constitution, Article IV, Finance, Section C.</p> <p>RATIONALE: 2018 adopted amendment: Section C. Payment of Dues and Fees</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The membership year is July 1-June 30. A member shall pay annual dues and fees no later than June 30 for the following fiscal year. 2. For membership or reinstatement commencing between July 1 and December 31, the member shall pay induction fee (new member only), dues, and scholarship fee for the current year.

		<p>For membership commencing on or after January 1, the member shall pay one-half of the international membership dues. Chapter and state organization dues may be pro-rated as the chapter/state organization determines.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Immediately thereafter, the state organization and international portions of the dues and fees shall be sent to the state organization treasurer. 4. The international portion of the dues and fees shall be sent between July 1 and September 30. 5. A member who fails to complete payment of international dues shall be dropped as of October 1. 6. PROVISIO: This bylaw will take effect in 2019.

7	Page 15-16, STANDING RULES	<p>Section 2. Finances, 2.21 Current wording: The Eva Philip Curry State Scholarship Fund shall receive eighty cents (\$.80) of the one dollar (\$1.00) per active and reserve member annually Proposed Amendment: The Eva Phillip curry State Scholarship Fund shall receive: (1) 100% of the one dollar (\$1.00) collected per active and reserve member annually if the chapter has no scholarship fund, or (2) 20% of the one dollar (\$1.00) collected per active and reserve member annually if the chapter has a scholarship fund.</p>
